



TheWashBoard.org is a new, free, web-based scholarship clearinghouse that matches Washington scholarship seekers with Washington scholarship providers.

TheWashBoard.org makes scholarship searching simple. In one stop, students search and apply for multiple scholarships specific to their academic interests, college or university, or by other criteria. Unlike search engines, theWashBoard.org is advertising and spam-free and will never sell a scholarship seeker's personal information.

Scholarship providers benefit from the increased exposure, flexible administrative options, reduced paperwork, and access to statewide scholarship trend data.

Word about theWashBoard.org is spreading across the state. Over thirty thousand scholarship seekers and a hundred and twenty-five scholarship providers are registered. At the spring 2010 peak, over \$14 million in scholarship funds was available. New scholarships are added each week.

- ❖ Juliette Riley is the recipient of the Patricia Fisher Endowed Scholarship from The Seattle Foundation. She created a profile on TheWashBoard.org and applied for scholarships during her senior year. "The web-based process is a more efficient way to apply for multiple scholarships. After I created a profile, theWashBoard.org automatically copied my profile information and placed it into The Seattle Foundation's scholarship application. I saved a lot of time because I didn't have to re-type the same information into multiple scholarships."

- ❖ Jeffrey Hill is the recipient of the Grays Harbor Community Foundation Scholarship and the NELA Scholars Scholarship. He is a veteran, who was laid-off from a manufacturing position that he held for over eight years. "My list of scholarship matches was extensive and informative.
