- Increase student achievement in all content areas.

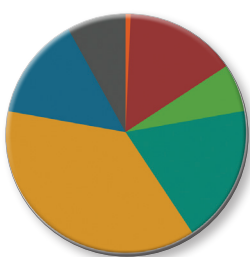
HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2010-11

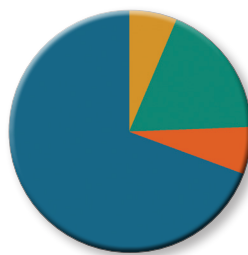
WHO WE ARE AT ACADEMY OF CITIZENSHIP & EMPOWERMENT
