- 100% of eligible 8th-grade students signed up for College Bound Scholarship.

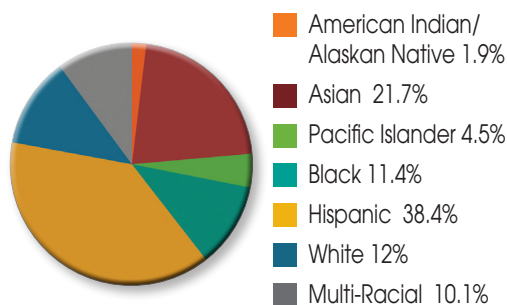
INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE

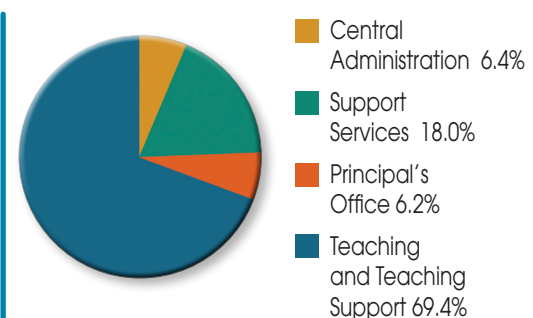
WHO WE ARE AT CASCADE MIDDLE SCHOOL
