- Staff focus on ELL supports.

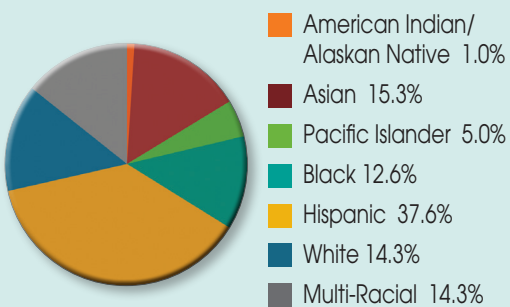
HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2010-11

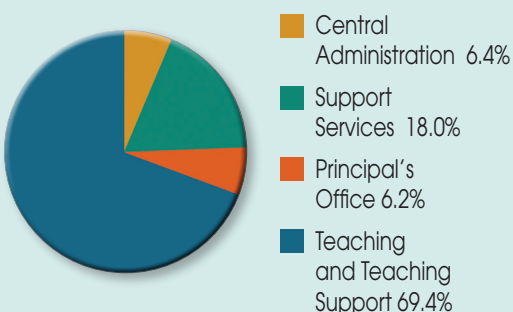
WHO WE ARE AT CHINOOK MIDDLE SCHOOL
