Highline High School is on a 6 period day. Students take six classes a day five days a week with two 18 week terms. They also attend an advisory class twice a week for 35 minutes per class. Monday through Wednesday they are in class for a total of 55 minutes per class. On Thursdays they are in class for a total of 50 minutes per class. On Fridays in class for a total of 35 minutes. A 30 minute lunch period is provided.

Students earn 1.0 credit for each year long class. Some classes are 18 weeks long for which students receive a .5 credit. Student can also earn a .25 credit for advisory. A total of 6.25 credits can be earned each year.

Grading System

The traditional A, B, C, D, F system is used with a 4-point GPA computed cumulatively on a semester basis.
