II. WHY BOARD ACTION IS NECESSARY

Board action is necessary because all Readiness to Learn funds for partnerships must be approved by the school board, per the State Learning Assistance Program requirements. This is routine because we have an annual allocation of Readiness to Learn funds that are applied to partnerships.

III. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Highline set aside State Learning Assistance Program funding to support Readiness to Learn funds partnerships (up to 5% of the total allocation). The funds are intended for partnerships that support schools and the district in reducing discipline referrals, truancy petitions, and barriers to learning, as well as improving attendance, access to basic needs, student and family engagement with school life, and academic achievement.

The partnership funds were divided for extended learning opportunities for students and school-based restorative practices implementation.

Partnership applications to access dollars were released to elementary schools. A committee reviewed the applications, and one partnership met the requirement for a total of \$9,916

Lego Play-Well TEKnologies was approved by the review committee for \$9,916 to administer STEAM learning at McMicken Heights Elementary School.
