II. WHY BOARD ACTION IS NECESSARY

The Highline School District's Board of Directors is required to accept the Value Engineering Study Report with the implementation plan for the Tyee High School Replacement Project in accordance with WAC 392-343-080 and WAC 392-344-065 and the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) Form D-7, Application to Proceed with Bid Opening.

III. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Sazan Environmental Services was selected to conduct a value engineering study for the Tyee High School Replacement Project. A value engineering study is an organized approach to optimize both cost and performance in a facility or to identify items that add cost without contributing to the function of the facility. In evaluating the quality, use, life, appearance, and required features of a facility, the value engineering study seeks to achieve value without reducing quality below required levels while maximizing function, cost, and value in design.

The final Value Engineering Study Report with an implementation matrix was completed in April 2022. District staff is applying components of the value engineering ideas into the design of the building. The Tyee High School Replacement Project will be partially funded through OSPI. OSPI's Form D-7, Application to Proceed with Bid Opening requires the board of directors to accept the Value Engineering Study Report with implementation plan. A copy of the Value Engineering Study Report with implementation plan is available for review upon request.
